COACHING STANDARDS

- 1) Serving as a head or assistant coach in the Crossover ministry for the Lord Jesus Christ is a privilege and a calling. It is not a right or a mere volunteer opportunity, and the Crossover ministry leadership, including the pastors and appointed spiritual leaders of the sponsoring churches, retains the right to approve of all coaches.
- 2) Each head coach must be a born-again believer in Jesus Christ, as defined by Scripture, and be able to communicate his or her Christian conversion experience. All coaches must willingly agree to and abide by the Crossover statement of faith.
- 3) Because of the high value of working with children and youth, all coaches (head and assistant) shall successfully complete both a Ministry Team Application, AND a formal background check prior to being approved to coach. Coaches may not coach a team without a completed background check administered by Crossover Basketball.
- 4) Coaches shall regularly attend worship services and be growing and active participants in their local church family.
- 5) Coaches commit to conduct themselves in a manner worthy of their calling as believers in Jesus Christ, and as influencers of youth. This includes an earnest effort to live above reproach and apply biblical guidelines in such areas as, but not limited to, internet use, sexual purity, drugs and alcohol, abusive language, or other personal conduct which would reflect poorly on or distract from their personal commitment to Christ, godly lifestyle, and coaching influence with the children.
- 6) By serving in Crossover ministry, all coaches and leaders agree to submit to the teaching of scripture and a grace-filled accountability with the Crossover leadership team and/or pastoral representatives from the partner churches. Any concerns regarding lifestyle issues will be addressed personally and on a case-by-case basis with intent toward growth and restoration and the ultimate glory of God.

CROSSOVER SEASON CALENDAR

Summer

Optional and invitational coaches training, discipleship and mentoring.

August - September

Three scheduled skill evaluations are held.

Mid October

Coaches receive team rosters, attend a coach clinic and meet other coaches in their division at the pre-season coach meeting.

November

Once a week, mid-week practices begin.

December - February

Saturday games begin the first week of December and run through mid February. The season is nine games and culminates with a celebration of all teams and families with food, prizes, entertainment, and a special message from a sports celebrity.
